Grant Program

The NCHSSVA is in a unique position serving as the initial organizational body for overseeing the establishment of beach volleyball clubs at high schools within the state of North Carolina with the eventual goal being that beach volleyball becomes a varsity sanctioned sport. In order to achieve that eventual goal there is ultimately a need to establish an infrastructure of beach volleyball facilities on or near high school campuses. With that need in mind, the NCHSSVA has established a grant program utilizing surplus money available on a year-to-year basis. The board of the NCHSSVA reserves the right to determine whether any grants are awarded each year and if so, how many and for how much.

Applications for consideration for the current fiscal year (July 1st-June 30th) must submit the application provided on Page 2 of this document by the following deadlines with grant awards being offered within 30 days of the deadline:

2017/2018 Fiscal Year and beyond – May 1st in current fiscal year

Grant awards for projects that do not start by March 1 of the following fiscal year will be released and made available for the next round of grant approvals.

Any individual or group can submit an application for consideration as long as it is shown that the facility project for which funds are requested for will be able to serve the need of accommodating high school beach volleyball practices and/or competitions.
